A. 66.03.01 Inter-District Agreement – Approval

The Virtual program operated by the District has attracted a number of students from School Districts around the State. The Department of Public Instruction does not allow open enrollment into the Wisconsin Rapids Virtual program, however non-resident students are allowed into the program, provided the resident School District agrees to a cooperative 66.03.01 agreement. Any additional cost to provide Special Education services under each agreement remains the responsibility of the resident School District.

The District with which we need an approved 66.03.01 agreement at this time is as follows:

Students In

Necedah - 14 students - grades 4K, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, - Virtual

The administration recommends the 66.03.01 cooperative agreement for students attending the Virtual program from the Necedah School District as listed be recommended for approval to the Board of Education.

B. District Interschool Delivery – Discussion and Possible Action

The District currently contracts with an outside service to provide daily interschool mail delivery and Food Service meal delivery from Lincoln High School to various elementary schools in Wisconsin Rapids.

As Administration works to increase security in all District school buildings, some concerns have developed regarding who holds keys that access a number of those buildings. A possible solution to the concern would be to have District employees provide interschool mail and Food Service deliveries.

The administration will be recommending to the committee a proposal that we believe to be cost neutral and would bring interschool mail and Food Service deliveries in house.

#### A. Purchases – Update

Listed as Attachment A are copies of a purchase from Mid-State Technical College for transcripted credits, SRI Consultants for work on insurance claims, M W Tighe Roofing for roof repairs, and Complete Control for technician services.

#### B. Application for Fuel Up to Play 60 Grant – Update

The Food Service Department is planning to submit an equipment grant through Fuel Up to Play 60 for the following schools: Grove, Howe, Lincoln, Mead and Rudolph, for a total of \$16,470. The equipment requests include a reach-in freezer for Grove, a milk cooler for Mead, a milk cooler for Lincoln, a "grab and go" lunch station for Lincoln, a salad bar for Rudolph, lunch trays for Mead, and service trays and carts for Howe. There is a limit of \$5,000 per school which limits the type of equipment we are able to request.

# C. Host Site for AmeriCorps Farm to School – Update

The Food Service Program was approved to be a host site for two part-time AmeriCorps Farm to School Members for the 2016-17 school year. One of the members will focus on Nutrition Education and the other will focus on Community Outreach, which includes school gardens, Farm to School events, and local food procurement. The hiring and supervision of these members will be a collaborative process between Lizzie Severson, Food Service Director, and the Farm to School Leads at the Wood County Health Department. We are currently accepting applications for the two AmeriCorps positions and the posting is on the WRPS website under Non-Certified Vacancies: http://www.wrps.org/humanresources/ncjobpositions.cfm.
