A. iPad Purchase - Approval

The District is in the process of replacing our aging fleet of iPads. We are ready to purchase another 100 iPad replacements to be placed into classrooms at the elementary level (see attachment A).

The Administration recommends purchasing 100 iPads from Apple in the amount of \$31,150 to be funded from the 2021-22 Technology referendum budget.

B. Wax Supply Bid – Approval

Central Storage has submitted bids for custodial wax supplies for the summer of 2022. This bid was sent to 6-vendors and we received quotes from 5-vendors. This cost will come from the 2021-22 Buildings and Grounds budget (see attachment B).

The Administration recommends accepting the proposals from Nassco in the amount of \$19,054.96, Hillyard in the amount of \$21,222.74, and Dalco in the amount of \$57.00.
