A. Board Policy 451 - Student Insurance Program / 780 - Insurance Management – First Reading

The District has offered student accident insurance on a voluntary basis in accordance with Board Policy 451 - Student Insurance Program for decades with little or no participation by families. With the healthcare marketplace and other options available for insurance, families have had no need or interest in paying the premium cost of this optional insurance. There is no statutory requirement for the District to provide this insurance offering to families, and there could be some efficiencies realized if staff do not need to spend time and resources to communicate the offering for families. First Agency, the District's current carrier, has notified the District of its intent to cancel coverage renewal for the upcoming 2022-23 school year due to a lack of participation. In checking with other area school districts such as Marshfield, Wausau, Port Edwards, and Nekoosa, they have moved away from providing the insurance offering due to its expense and lack of participation (see Attachment A).

The Administration recommends approval of the deletion of Policy 451 - Student Insurance Program for first reading.

In addition, the deletion of Policy 451 caused a review of Policy 780 - Insurance Management which cross-references Policy 451. The language contained in Policy 780 is still sufficient; however, the irrelevant cross references toward the bottom should be removed as indicated (see Attachment B).

The Administration recommends approval of the proposed changes to Policy 780 - Insurance Management for first reading.

B. Skyward Financial Software Conversion – Approval

EMS Linq Inc., who provides the District with our financial software, has informed us that they will be transitioning their financial platform and the cost will be increasing from \$21,610.00 per year to approximately \$45,000.00 per year. With this news we have met with Skyward who we currently use for our student database management. After receiving a demonstration of their Human Resource, Payroll and Financial modules, a price quotation has been secured.

There are a number of advantages in moving to Skyward:

- The software would help create efficiencies in the HR Department by uploading new hire data from WECAN into Skyward HR and electronic onboarding of new staff.
- Payroll would see efficiencies with improvement of payroll related reports and quicker access to employee information.
- School finance will see efficiencies by the use of paperless purchase orders, receiving, check requests and journal entries.
- Detailed building and department budgets would be entered directly into the software by Administration and support staff.
- Salary and benefit information would also be entered and/or uploaded into the budget with extreme accuracy.
- Skyward financial would work seamlessly with the student data base in regards to payment of fees from families.
- The Business Department would have visibility to student based activity funds and it would be reflected to the District's general ledger in real-time.

Nine individuals from the Human Resource, Payroll, Financial and Technology Departments participated in Skyward's demonstration and there was unanimous agreement to recommend a conversion to Skyward.

There will be an upfront cost for this conversion which would begin with initial transition work starting in the month of September, 2022 and moving to full conversion by April 1, 2023. The first and second year there will be a combined additional investment of \$121,000.00. Each subsequent year Skyward's cost is estimated to be around \$16,000.00 to \$23,000.00 less than Linq (see Attachment C).

The Administration recommends transitioning the District financial data base from Linq to Skyward with a formal start date of April 1, 2023. Transition and future financial software costs will be paid for by the District's Business Office budget.

C. Interactive Flat Panel (IFP) Purchase - Approval

The Lincoln High School Math Department is in need of replacing their current SmartBoards from 2007. After various trials and demonstrations of interactive flat panel (IFP) displays, the Technology Department has selected BenQ IFP's to replace the aging SmartBoards. The new IFP's offer significant changes in hardware and software functionality over the older boards. The Technology Department will also plan to replace all current District SmartBoards with BenQ IFP's over the next year as time and resources allow (see Attachment D).

The Administration recommends the purchase of nine 86" BenQ IFP's from BG Innovations at a total cost of \$35,100.00 to be funded from the 2022-23 Technology Referendum Account.

D. Security Surveillance Purchase – Approval

In the spring of 2022 Ed Allison, Director of Buildings and Grounds, along with the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department and the building Principals completed a security audit that revealed several additional areas around the school buildings that should have increased security surveillance. In consultation with our security vendor, a walk-through of each building was completed and the necessary quote was developed to incorporate further camera security in our buildings. Each building ranged in cost from \$2,800.00 to nearly \$11,000.00 depending on the scope of the additional cameras. The Buildings and Grounds Department along with the Technology Department has reviewed all the proposed cameras and would like to move forward

with the installation of these additional cameras. The total cost for all of the proposed projects is \$68,202.00 and because these projects are part of the District 10-year Facility Plan, the proposal is to use dollars from Fund 46 to complete this project. The only buildings that are not included at this time are Grant Elementary and the Buildings and Grounds facility since they have sufficient camera coverage (see Attachment E).

The Administration recommends the purchase and installation of additional security surveillance cameras at Grove, Howe, Mead, THINK, Washington, Woodside, Pitsch, Wisconsin Rapids Middle School, East Junior High, Lincoln High School and River Cities High School from Systems Technology at a total cost of \$68,202.00 to be funded from Fund 46 in accordance with the District 10-year Facility Plan.

Over the course of the past few weeks, Lynx Transportation Solutions, Lamers Bus Lines and Safe-Way Bus Transit have been working on school bus routes. At this time, they have completed the secondary morning and afternoon routes which consist of 27 routes. Last school year there were 37 secondary routes. Over the next couple of weeks elementary routing will take place. Through the month of August, the Administration will be reviewing policies and procedures pertaining to walking distances to school and pay-to-ride requirements, and provide further updates to the Board in September.

451 STUDENT INSURANCE PROGRAM

A group plan of student accident insurance shall be made available on a voluntary basis to every district student from early childhood through grade 12, the cost of which shall be borne by the student. The specific plan, which will provide for the insurance agent's assuming all administrative processes, shall be approved by the Board.

Accident insurance is required for all students who participate in secondary school athletic programs. Catastrophe insurance for students engaged in athletics is provided as a supplement

780 INSURANCE MANAGEMENT

The insurance coverage of the school district should provide the broadest, most complete coverage available, to be secured at the most economical cost to the District consistent with sound insurance principles.

Liability Insurance

The Board shall carry a general liability policy to cover all school premises, activities and operation under control of the Board. This shall include teacher liability. The Board shall purchase, with District funds, the type and amount of insurance necessary to protect itself as a corporate body, its individual members, its appointed officers and its employees from financial loss arising out of any claim, demand, suit or judgment by reasons of alleged negligence or other act resulting in accidental injury to any person or in property damage within or without the school buildings while the above-named insured are acting in the discharge of their duties within the scope of their employment and/or under the direction of the Board.
