A. Interactive Flat Panels Purchase – Approval

The administration is interested in continuing to purchase BenQ Interactive Flat Panels (IFP's) from BG Innovations for classrooms to replace the aging Smart Boards. This next purchase will provide English Language Arts classrooms at WRAMS, fourth grade classrooms at all elementary schools, and a handful of other classrooms throughout the district needing Smart Board replacements.

At the time of the Business Services agenda publishing, quotes from the vendor were not available. Phil Bickelhaupt, Director of Technology, will provide quotes and a recommendation for purchase at the Business Services Committee meeting.

The administration recommends approval to purchase BenQ Interactive Flat Panels and Balance Box mounts from BG Innovations as proposed to be funded from the 2023-2024 Technology Budget.

B. Audit Proposal – Memorandum of Understanding – Approval

Hawkins Ash CPAs has been completing the District's audits, assisting with accounting questions, providing guidance with Fund 80 accounting, and maintaining the fixed asset accounting requirements for several years. The company is also familiar with the District's daily, monthly, and annual procedures. The administration would like to continue working with Hawkins Ash CPAs to provide continuity and stability in District's accounting procedures (see Attachment A).

The administration recommends approval of the Memorandum of Understanding with Hawkins Ash CPAs for 3 years of audit services to be provided for the following fiscal years: 2023-24 for \$25,400.00, 2024-25 for \$26,650.00, and 2025-26 for 27,975.00.

B. CESA 5 Reimbursement - Update

The District has received notice that CESA 5 has exceeded its annual revenue projection for the 2022-23 school year. The Board of Control at CESA 5 approved a disbursement of \$250,000.00 to its members. The Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools' portion of this reimbursement is \$8,911.62 (see Attachment B).

C. Utility Cost Summary Report – Update

Ed Allison, Director of Buildings and Grounds, will present the utility cost summary report to the Business Services Committee. The utility costs being reviewed are electric, natural gas, lighting, sewer, water fire suppression, storm water and snow plowing (see Attachment C).

D. Financial Statements and Independent Auditors Report on Communication with those charged with Governance and Management Advisory Comments - Review

A short review of the 2022-23 audited financial statements will be provided by Aaron Nelson, Director of Business Services. The District's audited fund balance is \$17,125,364, which is up \$2,445,561.00 from the start of the 2022-23 school year which equates to 22% of total revenues.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into on December 18, 2023, between the Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools, hereafter referred to as the District, and Hawkins Ash CPAs, LLP, hereafter referred to as the Auditor. The parties agree as follows:

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The Auditor shall perform an audit of the governmental activities, each major fund and the aggregate remaining fund information, which collectively comprise the basic financial statements of the District as of, and for the years ended June 30, 2024, 2025 and 2026. The purpose of our audits is to enable us to express our opinion on the basic financial statements. We will conduct our audits in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, *Government Auditing Standards*, and Uniform Guidance (if applicable).

No audit can give absolute assurance that errors and irregularities will be detected. If conditions are discovered that lead us to believe that material errors, defalcations, or other irregularities may exist, or if any other circumstances are encountered that require extended services, we will promptly inform management.

3. REPORTS

The Auditor shall submit to the District the following reports:

- (a) Financial statements and an Independent Auditors' Report on the basic financial statements
- (b) Independent Auditors' Report on Internal Control over Financial Reporting and on Compliance and Other Matters Based on an Audit of Financial Statements Performed in Accordance with *Government Auditing Standards*

- (d) Current and Prior Year Schedule of Findings and Questioned Costs
- (e) Independent Auditors' Report on Communication with Those Charged with Governance
- (f) Independent Auditors' Report on Management Advisory Comments (if applicable)
- (g) Data Collection Form (if applicable)
- (h) Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction PI-1506-AC internet filing
- (i) Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction State Aid Membership Report (if applicable)
- (j) Irregularities and illegal acts (if applicable)
- (k) Board presentation, if requested

CESA 5 is recognized as a leader in providing educational services. We are fortunate to have a team of dedicated staff members and strong partnerships with school districts, government agencies, and other stakeholders. These factors are instrumental in enhancing our capabilities, expanding the scope of services we offer, and positioning us as the go-to resource for schools.

Background regarding this payment to your school district

CESA 5 has an annual budget of over \$32 million with over 275 employees. CESAs receive no tax funding and only generate funds when they sell services, like a private business.

At the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year, CESA 5 exceeded its annual revenue projections. Following similar action in the previous school year, the CESA 5 Board of Control (which is comprised of dedicated school board members from CESA 5 school districts) has authorized the dispersal of a total of \$250.000 to our member school districts.

Summary of the payments made to your school district by CESA 5

Following the 2021-2022 school year: \$18,295.84 Following the 2022-2023 school year (this payment): \$8,911.62

Where is this "additional" revenue from?

Additional funds come from various supplementary sources such as:

- Special Projects by Staff
 Our staff take on additional projects throughout the year (such as literacy audits, strategic planning, special education department audits, and superintendent searches).
- 2. Surpassing Training and Support Demands
 Requests for training and support have exceeded initial projections, leading to additional revenue from activities such as workshop & conference registrations, sales of early childhood curriculum, and requests for software support & implementation.



3. Interest on Bank Accounts Recently, interest earned on our bank accounts surpassed the initially projected figures, providing additional revenue.

These supplementary revenue streams, while not initially factored into our service pricing structure due to their uncertainty, contribute to our overall financial stability and support our continued commitment to delivering high-quality educational services to your school district.

How is the payment determined?

Each member district's payment will be based on the cost of their services on the 2023-2024 CESA 5 annual service agreement (based on a snapshot taken in November 2023). For example, if the contract amount for "District A" represents 3% of the total of all member school district's contracted services, the payment to "District A" would be \$7,500 (i.e., \$250,000 x 3%).

What does the school district need to know to process this payment?

We recommend using WUFAR code 10 R 800 590 500000 000 in your revenue accounts.

Will this payment happen every year?

No, even though this payment has been made in consecutive years, we do not anticipate this occurring every year.
