- BS-1 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, to approve of Board Policy 830.2 Facility Use Policy for the Rapids Area Sports Complex, Board Policy 830 Use of School Facilities, and Board Policy 830.1 Facility Use Policy for the Performing Arts Center, all for first reading. Motion carried unanimously.
- B. Lease Agreement with CESA 5 for the Vesper Community Academy Facility
  - BS-2 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to approve a lease agreement with CESA 5 for use of the Vesper Community Academy Facility for the 2022-23 school year, in an amount of \$24,000.00. Motion carried unanimously.
- C. Special Education Wheelchair Van Purchase
  - BS-3 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, to purchase a Chrysler Voyager special education wheelchair van from Ewald Motors of Oconomowoc LLC for a total net cost of \$41,458.50 to be funded from the Special Education Budget. Motion carried unanimously.

- D. Chromebook Cases Purchase
  - BS-4 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to purchase 1,500 Chromebook cases for WRAMS and LHS from Bump Armor at an approximate cost of \$20.19 per unit, for a total cost of \$30,291.91 to be funded from the 2021-22 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget. Motion carried unanimously.

  - BS-5 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, to purchase 800 Chromebook 11 G8 EE's for WRAMS and LHS from PDS at a cost of \$253.78 per unit, for a total cost of \$203,024.00 to be funded from the 2021-22 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget.
