BADGER CARE

If your employment status has changed and you no longer have health insurance, you might be eligible for BadgerCare. Visit www.badgercareplus.org or call 1-800-362-3002 to find out about free or low-cost health care and nutrition benefits. You can also visit www.access.wi.gov to apply for nutrition benefits.

If you are not eligible for BadgerCare but need help paying for medication, contact the local American Red Cross at 423-7360. They are now offering the *YourRxCard* Program, a free prescription drug savings program to all Americans. You can also visit www.familywize.com/ to find out about the Family Wize prescription card, another free prescription drug savings program.

Assistance with eye exams and prescription glasses may also be available if you are not covered by BadgerCare or other health insurance. Contact your school nurse for more information about this program.
