C. Co-Curricular Appointment Letter Verbiage

Brian Oswall, Director of Human Resources, shared with the Committee that some districts are adding a new verbiage line to their co-curricular letters to prepare for the possibility of school closure and/or a season cancellation. For athletic co-curricular letters, the new line will say, "In the event of a season being cancelled coaching compensation will be prorated." For academic co-curricular letters, the new line will say, "In the event of school closure, your compensation for this activity may be prorated."

D. Chemical Hygiene Officer Stipend

Brian Oswall, Director of Human Resources, shared with the Committee how the Chemical Hygiene Officer is currently covered by the District Science Coordinator position and how the time allocated for this role has changed over the past three years. In addition, Craig Broeren, Superintendent, explained some of the responsibilities of the Chemical Hygiene Officer and shared that this position is a requirement for all school districts. The Committee recommended a \$1500 stipend for the Chemical Hygiene Officer position, as part of the District Science Coordinator position.
