Board Policy 380.1 - Therapy Dogs in Schools

E. 2022-2023 Open Enrollment Data Review and Application Approvals

Brian Oswall, Director of Human Resources, shared the current number of open enrollment transfer in and transfer out applications for the WRPS District. As of May 2, 2022, WRPS has 41 transfer in applications and 88 transfer out applications.

F. ESSER Funds

Brian Oswall, Director of Human Resources, explained to the Committee that current enrollment numbers and ESSER sections has created a need to use one of our elementary ESSER sections to hire an elementary physical education teacher.

PS – 8 Motion by Troy Bier, seconded by Larry Davis to approve using one of the elementary ESSER sections to add another elementary physical education teacher for the 2022-2023 school year.

Motion carried unanimously.

G. Support Staff Assignment Adjustment

Mr. Oswall explained to the Committee that adding 0.50 hours to the 4K aide hours will allow the aides time with the teacher before and after students are present.

PS – 9 Motion by Troy Bier, seconded by Larry Davis to approve an increase from 6.0 hours per day to 6.5 hours per day at Grant Elementary, THINK Academy, Woodside Elementary and Pitsch Early Learning Center for six District 4K aides, starting with the 2022-2023 school year.

H. Keyboarding Position

Mr. Oswall shared with the Committee that making the District elementary keyboarding instructor position a 1.0 FTE would allow the individual to offer more technology lessons that have been created by the District Library Media Specialist.

PS – 10 Motion by Larry Davis, seconded by Troy Bier to approve increasing the District elementary keyboarding instructor position to a 1.0 FTE effective for the 2022-2023 school year.

I. Reading Specialist Position

Director of Human Resources, Brian Oswall, shared with the Committee that due to staff members leaving, the District needs to hire an elementary reading specialist.

PS – 11 Motion by Larry Davis, seconded by Troy Bier to approve an elementary reading specialist position for the 2022-2023 school year.

Motion carried unanimously.

J. Summer School Technology Positions

Mr. Oswall shared with the Committee the need for additional summer technology workers. Specifically, they would help with the installation of over 100 new sound systems in the District.
