#### C. Cool 2 Be Kind Advisor Stipend

Brian Oswall, Director of Human Resources, shared with the Committee some of the focuses of the Cool 2 Be Kind club. Specifically, the club welcomes/connects with new students, conducts random acts of kindness and recognition, builds awareness about issues such as bullying, teen dating violence, and mental health; and completes service learning projects. There are approximately 40 active members of the Cool 2 Be Kind club. In addition, Mr. Oswall shared that the Wisconsin Rapids Noon Rotary group has pledged \$500 to help pay for the Cool 2 Be Kind club advisor.

In addition, the current Athletic Trainer at Lincoln High School has been hired by Aspirus so this person will continue being the Athletic Trainer at Lincoln High School for the 2023-2024 school year.
