



T-Ball/Pitch Ball League Wisconsin Rapids Parks & Recreation Department * Registration begins March 3, 2025 *



Registration will remain open until spots are full!

T-Ball

Open to players 4-6 years old. Players will learn basic skills such as hitting, fielding, throwing, catching and running bases. Players will always bat off tee. Every player will get to play every inning!

Pitch Ball

Open to players 6-8 years old. Played on full-sized ball diamond. Players will learn and practice basic skills with emphasis on rules and sportsmanship. Coaches will pitch to their own team. Every player will get to play every inning and have a chance to play all positions.

Should you choose T-Ball or Pitch Ball?

If your child has NO baseball experience, choose T-Ball. If your child is familiar with the basics of baseball, choose Pitch Ball. It is possible that your child may be moved to the appropriate league based on their familiarity with baseball once the season begins.

Registration Fees: \$18 Resident, \$27 Non-Resident*

Each player receives a baseball cap (special thank you to E-Con Electric!), T-shirt (thank you to Crockett Septic, Pinnacle Performance Therapy, Solarus, and Advanced Tactical Medicine!), and placement on a team to practice skills and play games. (Limit of 10 players per team.) Child needs to provide glove, tennis shoes and water bottle.

*Non-Resident is defined as residence located <u>outside Wisconsin Rapids city limits</u>; i.e., Biron, Grand Rapids, Kellner, Nekoosa, Port Edwards, Rudolph, Saratoga, etc.

Parents are strongly encouraged to assist or coach their child's team; please consider signing up! No baseball experience is required; coaches are provided detailed practice plans.
