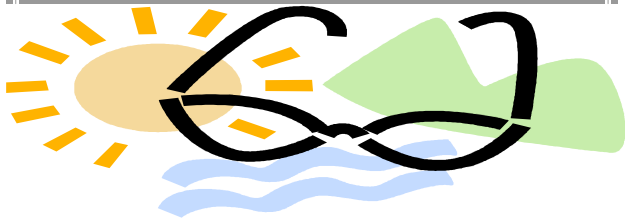

Meal Price for the 2009 – 2010 School Year

There will be no changes in the student or adult meal prices for next school year. Prices will continue to be:

\$1.10 elementary and secondary paid breakfast Free and reduced breakfast – no charge. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunch automatically qualify for free breakfast. \$1.65 elementary paid lunch, \$0.40 elementary reduced lunch, \$1.95 secondary paid lunch, and \$0.40 secondary reduced lunch. Additional milk or juice with meal – 30 cents

Online deposits will be accepted on the Mealtimes Online website through Wednesday, June 10. The deposit system will then be disabled for the summer, but you will still be able to view your student's account information online. A message will be posted on the Mealtimes Online website in the fall to indicate when online deposits can again be made.
