Examples of allowable uses (**with teacher permission**) are:

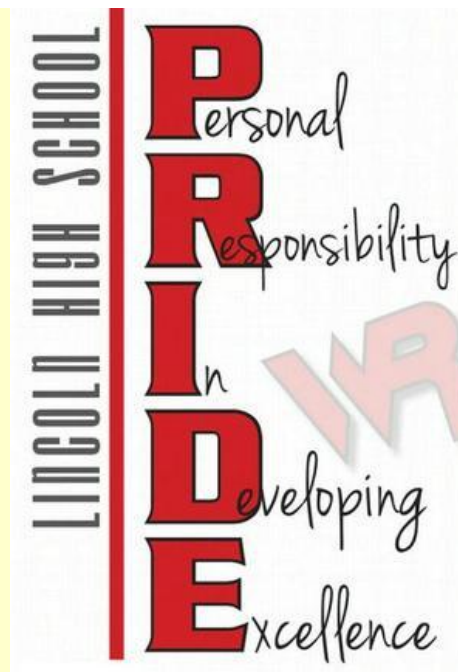
- Checking Mrs. Morman's website for homework, answers, and other information *during individual work time.*

Trimester grades will be based on:

20% - Formative assessment (examples include homework completion, homework checks, and in-class individual, partner, and group work.)

80% - Summative assessment (examples include quizzes, tests, and projects.)

Retake Policy: Students may retake a maximum of 2 Summative Assessments (either a quiz or a test) per trimester on which the student earned less than an 85%. The highest grade on the assessment, up to a maximum of 85%, will be the final grade. No retakes will be allowed during the final week of the trimester.
