## Registration

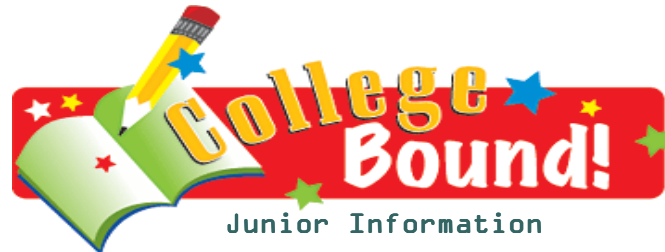
