# Tutoring

Tutoring is a great opportunity for your child to work one on one or in a small group with a staff member. The teachers will work with you to determine the best way to use your child's tutoring time. You may choose to have tutoring in an area in which your child is thriving and needs some enrichment activities, or you may choose to have an instructor tutor your child in an academic area in which they struggle.

## **Open Lab Grades 6-8**

Open labs are an optional, daily small group setting. Students are expected to work independently, in a quiet environment, much like a study hall. A teacher is available to answer questions and support students as needed. This differs from tutoring as it is not one-on-one support.

#### Writer's Workshop

Weekly writer's workshops are also available for all students in K-5.

#### **Reading and Math Intervention**

Students qualify for reading and math intervention services based on results from the screeners. These students will benefit from extra reading and/or math support typically on an online platform.

#### In-Person School Opportunity

We offer optional grade appropriate in-person classes at our Central Oaks Academy campus once a week. Our focus during in-person days are social/emotional skills and STEM/project based learning. Art, Phy-Ed, and Music classes are also an integral component of our classes.

## **Pupil Services**

Many family/student supports are available in the form of guidance counselor, school psychologist, social worker, etc.

## **Field Trips**

We offer several school wide activities throughout the year. Students may have the opportunity to participate in additional field trips with in-person school experience.

#### Family Events

During the course of the year, families are invited to attend a variety of Central Oaks events.

## Family Curriculum Budget

Each family is provided with a budget to purchase the following:

- Curriculum and Supplemental Material: All items must be approved and related directly to your curriculum.
- Lessons: Includes approved physical and musical activities. Lessons must take place regularly over an extended period of time. All curriculum needs must be purchased prior to submitting a lessons request.
- Curriculum Budget will be prorated according to student start date, if enrolling after the first trimester.



\*You may place a total of 3 orders each school year. You will place your first order prior to the school year. Your remaining budget (including lessons requests) are accessible from October 1st through February 15th.

# Technology

All students completing an online curriculum will be provided a device for the duration of the school year. All devices must be turned in by the end of the school year. If a loss of internet access occurs, a Kajeet (wifi hotspot) is available for checkout.
