We hope you and your family enjoy our Spring Break. Although the weather doesn't appear to be very warm in Rapids, we do hope that you enjoy the week off from school. When we return, there are only 10 weeks (9 weeks for Seniors) of school left in the 23-24 school year. Our office will only be open over Spring Break from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Make-Up State Assessment and Reality Check Information

- Juniors who did not complete the ACT state test will have make-up testing on Tuesday, April 9th at 7:30 a.m. in the Auxiliary Gym.
- Sophomores who did not complete the social studies-based Forward Exam will have their make-up on Thursday, April 11th at 7:30 a.m. in the Auxiliary Gym.
- Seniors who did not complete the Reality Check have received via email their alternative assignment from Mr. Siler. This must be completed for graduation.

Freshmen and Sophomores will be administered the PreACT Secure on Tuesday, April 9th. Juniors and Seniors may have brief work posted in Canvas for April 9th. In-person attendance is NOT required on April 9th for Juniors and Seniors. Upon completion of testing all students will have a study hall unless the parent completes this form to dismiss their child the remainder of the day. Students who do not complete this assessment on April 9th will have the make-up on Thursday, April 11th at 7:30 a.m. in the Auxiliary Gym.

On April 8th, a total solar eclipse will be making its way across North America.

• With such a monumental event occurring during the school day, Lincoln High School will be conducting a viewing of the event for students, faculty, and staff members who wish to participate. Students will have an extended 5th period (schedule below) when, at an appropriate time, classes will be escorted outside to view the eclipse. Our staff will also be conducting a community viewing session outside the South Wood County Recreation Center/Rapids Area Sports Complex.



• Safety is our top priority, and we would like both you and your student to be aware of the precautionary steps we are putting in place. Homemade or ordinary sunglasses are not sufficient ways to view an eclipse, as the reflectivity and polarization are not high enough for viewing safely. To ensure that each participant is safe, we will be supplying those who wish to participate with a pair of glasses specifically designed for eclipse viewing. If you wish for your child not to participate in the viewing, please complete this <u>form</u> and return it to the main office by Friday, April 5th.

There is a mandatory meeting for ALL Seniors (LHS & LVS) at 8:50 a.m. (during RPT) on Monday, April 15th in the PAC. Important graduation information will be shared and graduation orders will be delivered. All senior fees and fines MUST be paid by Friday, May 3. Check your student's Skyward Fee Management account for outstanding fees. Payments can be made online in Skyward or the main office. graduating class of 2025. Participating UW universities will proactively admit Wisconsin high school students, who have chosen to participate, based on their high school GPA, academic course work, and graduation from a participating Wisconsin high school. During the first year of the program, select Wisconsin high schools are participating. Lincoln High School is one of the pilot, partner schools.

Below are a few questions and answers from the Direct Admit Wisconsin website.

What are the eligibility requirements for students?

First, you must be enrolled in a participating school district and opt to participate in the program. Then, if you are on track to complete the credits required for admission – 4 units of English, 3 units of approved math, 3 units of social science, 3 units of natural science, and 4 additional academic units – you will receive an admission offer through Direct Admit Wisconsin.

When and how do students opt in for the Direct Admit Wisconsin program?

Students in the Class of 2025 at participating high schools will agree to participate during the 3rd trimester of their junior year. In the future, the choice to participate will become a part of the regular registration process for incoming junior students. This will be completed through the Family Access portal in Skyward. What is the deadline for students/families to opt in?

Students and families for the Class of 2025 must opt in by June 3, 2024.

Students need to be in class every day. Even two days missed per month makes the student habitually truant by state definition. Please encourage your child to be in school every day and please submit doctor's notes for medical appointments to our attendance office.
