We are nearing the progress report time at LHS as Term 1 is now 42% complete. Parent-Teacher Conferences are on Monday, October 12th from 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. To sign-up for a five-minute appointment, view our October newsletter with directions on the last two pages [here](#).

This upcoming week is back to a full five day "normal week.". Cohort "A" will attend Lincoln on Monday, October 5th and Tuesday, October 6th. Cohort "B" will attend LHS on Thursday, October 8th and Friday, October 9th.

This week we have had more students quarantined due to close contact with students displaying the symptoms of COVID-19. I cannot stress enough the need for all of us to maintain six feet of distance from other individuals in and out of the school building. We want to continue in-building instruction but decisions being made outside of school are increasing the amount of community spread and impacting LHS. In addition, if your child is to be COVID-19 tested in order to return to school, a negative test result needs to be provided (doctor's note, a screenshot of an online portal, entrance in the state database). As mentioned in the past two weeks, students will have about 60-75 minutes of work per class on the off-campus learning day. Student attendance for these days is directly tied to what the student accomplishes and/or produces over the given period of time. The assignments completed essentially becomes the evidence that a student has been in attendance, and if no work is produced, then a student is not considered to be in attendance and will be marked truant.


