
. It can take up to 3 hours but most students finish before that. Please know this test is not required and is only for students who are interested in taking the test. Taking the ASVAB test does not mean your child has to enlist in the military! Sign up in the ACP Center.

Bus Passes for Bus Riders ONLY — If your child will be riding a different bus to or from school than the bus they normally ride, they must get a bus pass from the office. If your child will be taking the same bus but will have a different drop-off or pick-up, they must also get a pass. Please send a signed, dated note with your child and a pass will be given to them. If your child does not ride a bus, they will not be given a bus pass to ride with another student. Passes will only be given to students who are assigned a bus route. Walkers and pickups are not allowed to ride the bus home with a bus student.
