- For any changes to your student's dismissal routine, please notify the school office in advance.


Bright by Text is a free program that sends tips and resources for healthy child development to parents & caregivers cell phones.


Help students stay warm this winter. ITEMS NEEDED:



On **Saturday**, **October 14**, a partial solar eclipse will be visible in Wisconsin Rapids. The eclipse will begin when the moon starts to block the sun at **10:34 AM**. The eclipse will slowly build until <u>11:53 AM</u>, when the moon will cover 53% of the sun. After reaching its maximum, the eclipse will gradually wane until the moon clears the face of the sun at 1:15 PM.

Looking directly at the sun can cause permanent vision loss, even during a partial solar eclipse. Sunglasses, X-ray film, and most welding shields will not block enough light to protect your vision. However, there are safe ways to view a solar eclipse.



WRPS staff will host students, families, and

interested community members for eclipse viewing events Saturday, October 14. On the East side of Rapids look for WRPS staff in the student parking lot at Lincoln High School. On the West side you'll find WRPS staff in the YMCA parking lot. Stop in to use telescopes with solar filters, pinhole viewers, and other projection methods to view the eclipse safely. A limited number of eclipse glasses will be available to purchase for \$1.00 each.



Eclipses are sensational and rare; and, if the weather cooperates, we have the chance to view one from beginning to end. We hope you'll join us for a memorable viewing experience.



All adult visitors that come into Grant Elementary during the school day MUST check into the main office and get a visitor

badge. *Bring a driver's license with you* so that a quick background check can be performed. Once the check is complete you will be given a badge to be worn while you are at Grant Elementary. When your visit is complete, stop in the main office to check out.

We appreciate your cooperation to help keep our students safe.



To ensure the safety of our students and staff members, any individual wishing to volunteer in any capacity must complete a volunteer application and undergo a criminal history records check (background check). Volunteers must be approved prior

to volunteering in any capacity including, but not limited to, helping in the classroom or on field trips.

Volunteers are required to reapply every 3 years. If you applied 3 years ago, you may have received an email notification from Background Investigation Bureau (BIB) - or you will be receiving one soon to renew your application. The deadline to submit a volunteer application is November 30, 2023. <u>Click here</u> for the link to submit your application.
