III. Actionable Items

A. Wisconsin School Nutrition Purchasing Cooperative 66.0301 Agreement

BS-1 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, that the proposed Wisconsin School Nutrition Purchasing Cooperative 66.0301 Agreement for the 2022-23 School Year in an amount of \$300.00 be recommended for approval to the Board of Education. Motion carried unanimously.

B. **CESA 5 Contract**

> BS-2 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, that the proposed CESA 5 agreement in the amount of \$437,722.00 for the 2022-23 school year be recommended for approval to the Board of Education. Motion carried unanimously.

C. WoodTrust Daktronics Video Display Board Loan Payoff

> BS-3 A motion was made by John Krings, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to pay the remaining WoodTrust Bank loan balance for the Daktronics video display board in the amount of \$391,889.00 from the District's General Fund. All sponsor and advertising revenues from the video display board will be deposited into the Quadplex and Stadium Sustainability Fund. Motion carried on a vote of 3-0 with 1 abstention. Troy Bier abstained.

D. **Grant Elementary Rewire**

> BS-4 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to contract with Current Technologies to rewire Grant Elementary for a total cost of \$42,757.00 to be funded 80% by the Federal Erate program and 20% from the 2022-23 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget. Motion carried unanimously.

- E. Wireless Access Point Refresh
 - BS-5 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, to purchase 120 Meraki Wireless Access Points from SHI International for a total cost of \$61,980.00 to be funded 80% by the Federal Erate program and 20% from the 2022-23 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget. Motion carried unanimously.
- F. Switch Upgrade
 - BS-6 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to purchase 80 Juniper switches with accessories and a 3-year support and licensing bundle from Bytespeed for a total cost of \$405,562.00 to be funded 80% by the Federal Erate program and 20% from the 2022-23 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget. Motion carried unanimously.
- G. Firewall Refresh Purchase
 - BS-7 A motion was made by Katherine Bielski-Medina, seconded by Troy Bier, to purchase 2 Fortinet Fortigate firewalls and support from PDS for a total cost of \$36,834.08 to be funded 80% by the Federal Erate program and 20% from the 2022-23 Technology and Curriculum Referendum Budget. Motion carried unanimously.
- H. Internet Access Contract
 - BS-8 A motion was made by Troy Bier, seconded by Katherine Bielski-Medina, to approve a 3-year contract with Solarus to provide 2GBs of internet access to the District at a monthly cost of \$2,300.00 to be funded 80% by the Federal Erate program and 20% from the 2022-23 Technology Budget. Motion carried unanimously.
