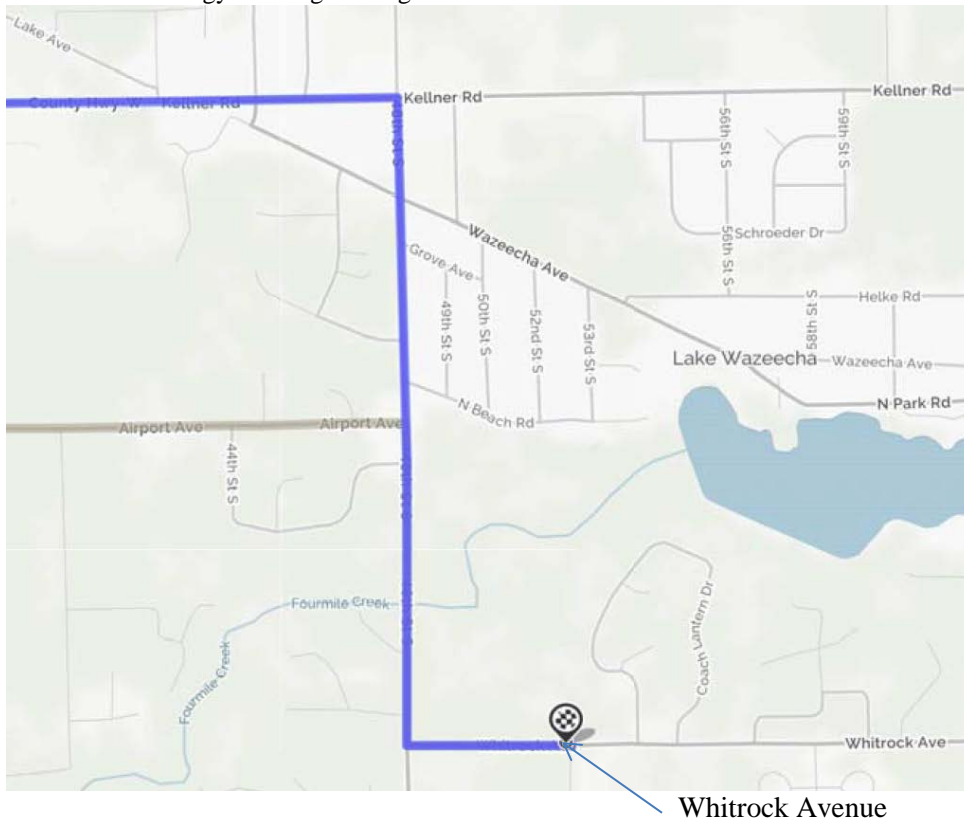
I. 2016-17 Building Trades House Project – Tour – (See map below for location)
