

Some Facts About LHS

- Lincoln High School (LHS) is a grade 10-12 comprehensive high school where all students
 are being prepared for college readiness and career success.
- LHS runs on a trimester schedule. This consists of a 5 period day with each class held approximately 70 minutes each. Students will receive a minimum of 6 credits and a maximum of 7.5 credits per year.
- LHS is proud to offer a strong curriculum, technology infused instruction, and approximately 170 courses to meet the diverse learning and career needs of all students.
- The curriculum currently includes as variety of 20 Advanced Standing (AS) offerings and Transcripted Credit Agreements with Mid-State Technical College. No fee is required to earn transcripted credit.
- We offer challenging courses in the career and technical education areas including Project Lead The Way engineering curriculum.
- Honors Option Courses are offered in curricular areas of Art, Business, Language Arts, Mathematics, Music, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages are available to students preparing for postsecondary education.
- LHS offers Central Cities Health Institute (CCHI) which is a two year medical career program which provides students with the opportunity to explore many facets of the healthcare industry.
- The LHS world language department offers four languages (French, German, Japanese, and Spanish). The fine arts are also a strong part of the curriculum at LHS.
- Students can choose from a variety of courses in the visual arts, music, and theatre/ drama areas. Students from these three areas often compete on state and national levels to gain recognition for their efforts, accomplishments and areas of expertise.
- LHS has a strong tradition of high-quality extra-curricular programs. Students have an opportunity to become involved in 21 interscholastic sports as well as more than 50 activities and clubs.
- LHS students have earned a high degree of respect for honors earned in regional, state and national competition.
