## Registration Sheet Back Continued

## Sign up for 6.0-7.5 credits

6.0 Credits = one study hall each term
6.5 Credits = two study halls, no study hall one term
7.0 Credits = study hall in one term, no study hall in other terms
7.5 Credits = no study halls

DO NOT sign up for study hall unless you are choosing a
specific term. Study hall will be placed into your schedule if you have less than 7.5 credits.

## Going to be freshmen continued

3. Would like to take other elective courses
