Sign up for 6.0-7.5 credits

6.0 Credits = one study hall each term

6.5 Credits = two study halls, no study hall one term

7.0 Credits = study hall in one term, no study hall in other terms

7.5 Credits = no study halls

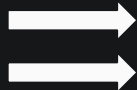

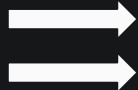

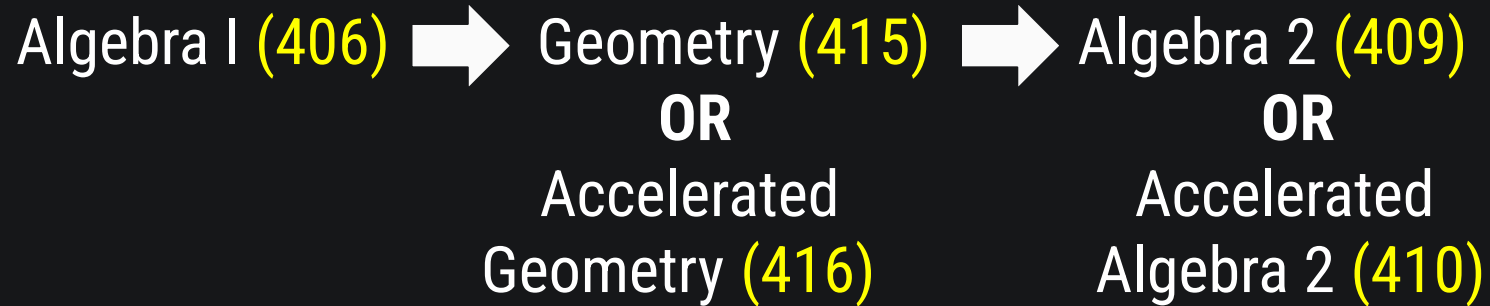

World Language Options

French, German or Spanish

If you are currently in one of the World Languages above and wish to continue - make sure you register for the correct level

EXAMPLE: If you are currently in Spanish I and wish to go to the next level, register for Spanish II

World language classes may not be repeated unless a grade of D, D-, or F is earned.

World Language Options

If you are currently in a world language part time this year, you are completing the A portion of either German I, Spanish I, or French I.

If you would like to complete the first level of your world language class next school year, you must register for the B portion on your registration sheet.

You may also register for the entire level II class next year.

World Language Chart

If you wish to reach level five of your world language at LHS, you must register for level II next year. Here is an example of what that plan may look like:

9th Grade	Spanish 1 B	Spanish 2 A	Spanish 2 B
