

Registration Sheet Back Continued

Sign up for 6.0-7.5 credits

- 6.0 Credits = one study hall each term
- 6.5 Credits = two study halls, no study hall one term
- 7.0 Credits = study hall in one term, no study hall in other terms
- 7.5 Credits = no study halls
- DO NOT sign up for study hall unless you are choosing a specific term. Study hall will be placed into your schedule if you have less than 7.5 credits.

Once you are finished selecting your courses:

Please write total credits on the line (this does NOT include alternates)



TOTAL CREDITS:

You must sign up for at least 6.0 credits.

You may take up to 7.5 credits.



Accelerated Geometry (416) -> Accelerated Algebra 2 (410) -> AP Precalculus (413) or AP Statistics (427) -> AP Calculus AB (423) or AP Calculus BC (425)
