6th Grade Science Kicks Off with Inquiry and Exploration!

Our 6th graders have jumped right into the world of science by learning how scientists think and ask questions through the Inquiry Process. To bring this to life, students headed out to the school prairie for some hands-on exploration. They practiced the skills real scientists use every day—observing carefully, comparing plants, classifying species, taking measurements, and making thoughtful inferences.

One of the highlights of the week was a trust-building activity called "Meet a Tree," where students relied on their senses (instead of their eyes!) to get to know a tree with the help of a classmate. It was a fun way to connect teamwork with scientific observation.
