A. 2016-17 Open Enrollment Data

The District received 60* applications from parents requesting their child(ren) be allowed to attend the Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools under the Open Enrollment Law, Wis. Stats §118.51, beginning with the 2016-2017 school year. The number of applications received from parents requesting open enrollment approval to attend a school district outside our District is 56*.

Currently under open enrollment there are 142 students attending WRPS from other school districts and 218 students who have transferred to other school districts. The District also has an additional 83 nonresident students attending WRPS under a 66.030 agreement. Following is a history of **initial open enrollment applications** that have been received.
