Additionally, Elizabeth Severson, Director of Food Services, shared with the Committee the need to add another kitchen helper position at Lincoln High School because of having three lunch periods and the increase in student numbers since the addition of the 9th graders at the high school. Lastly, Ed Allison, Director of Building and Grounds updated the Committee on the Project Search custodian helper position. The Project Search student has graduated and completed his externship and will begin working for the District as a custodian helper.
