

School-Wide Title One Summary Report 2012-2013

Accomplishments 2012-2013

- Title One funds were used to implement the Math Coach/Math Interventionist position
- Title One funds were used to support family involvement activities – including the summer book mailing
- Offered monthly Family Activity Nights. Each month there was a different curriculum focus. Students wrote about the content each month and displayed it on their lockers for parents to see.
- Write Tools training was provided to all teachers including a technology tool for students to use.
- Teachers used the new Common Core State Standards to set learning goals and designed assessments to measure accomplishment of the goals.

Looking Ahead to 2013-2014

- Plan to continue a full time Math Coach/Interventionist position, if funds are available.
- Write Tools training for teachers in August. Plan to create three common writing assessments on the three areas of writing for all students.
- School-wide implementation of iPads as a learning tool.
- Focus on increased school attendance with a variety of tools to prevent truancy.
- Strengthen the Reader's, Writer's, and Math workshop times by having clear goals and common assessments across each grade level.
- Increase the Parent/Family Involvement goal to a minimum of three positive interactions with each family during the school-year.
- Adding a Healthy Family Movie Night in September as another positive connection.
