

LHS Student P.R.I.D.E. Program (2023 - 24 School Year)

This opportunity is for our students who follow the [LHS P.R.I.D.E.](#) program ideals. Participation in receiving a PRIDE sticker is a privilege, not a right. The program is designed to reward students that meet the qualifications. Any form of disrespect or abuse of the PRIDE program will result in the immediate loss of the PRIDE sticker.

All forms are located in the office.

- A student P.R.I.D.E. Program packet is to be signed by a parent/guardian in order to leave campus.
- Gold Reinstatement forms list requirements for students to have their participation reinstated.
- Student ID cards with the current PRIDE sticker, must be presented when leaving and entering the building.
- If an ID is lost, a replacement must be purchased in the student services office with our Registrar for \$5.00.

Dates are not specific as to when students will receive the PRIDE sticker.

- Announcements will define dates and times students can pick up their PRIDE stickers.
- A student ID must be presented.
- At a minimum, formal grade checks will be done every six weeks.
- Checks will be done on a need basis for payment of fines/passing classes/discipline/etc.
- ***Students with privileges are expected to keep their grades at a B- or above or risk losing their privileges.**

Suspension or Revocation of PRIDE Rewards

Students will lose participation for:

- Failure to meet/maintain qualification requirements.
- Excessive tardies, absences and trancies.
- Violation of school rules including, but not limited to, discipline referrals or co-curricular code violations.
- Failure to provide an ID card when requested by staff.
- Obligations to the school include, but are not limited to, fines, fees, or detentions. All course fees for the term must be paid before PRIDE reward will be issued. Any concurrent class fees need to be paid in full by the first day of school.
- Inappropriate behavior while off school grounds during school hours.
- Violation of school parking lot rules.
- Transporting students on/off-campus during the school day who do not have PRIDE rewards.
- Participation will be revoked for the reasons described above, as well as by a teacher for excessive tardies, use of technology/phone in undesignated areas and times, or other legitimate reasons determined by the teachers and administration.

Reinstatement of PRIDE Rewards

- Students who have lost privileges at the end of the term may apply for reinstatement pending the next term's progress report grades.
- Students who have lost privileges at the progress report may apply for reinstatement pending the end-of-term grades.
- Students who have lost their privileges for all other reasons may request reinstatement. Reinstatement will only occur at/or around six-week increments.

All Students:

- Must have a signed Student PRIDE contract.
- Must complete reinstatement form in order to receive participation back if lost.
- You are expected to return from lunch and/or study hall and be on time for your next scheduled class.
- Reinstatement forms are half sheets found in the office.

Additional Information:

- **Students are required to attend all mandatory Raider Pride Times (RPT).**
- Students are required to attend all mandatory meetings, ACP events, assemblies, or school appointments.
- There will be no study hall release on days with a special schedule.
- Work, Work Experience, or Youth Apprenticeships are not excused absences if required to attend an LHS event during the day.
- Teachers can require students to attend Raider Pride Time or Study Hall at any time.

Freshmen To Qualify:
