## **School Districts:**

Area school districts are offering free pick-up meals for any children ages 18 and under who are not attending inperson classes. This includes children who are enrolled in the district but completing 100% of their learning virtually, children who are homeschooled, or children who are not yet enrolled in school because they are 4 years or younger.
