We are pleased to announce that Summer School planning has concluded, and WRPS will be hosting two sessions of summer school – the first session will be held from July 6-17, 2020; and the second session will be held from July 27-August 7, 2020. All registration will take place *online* beginning May 29, 2020. The last date to register for Summer School is June 10, 2020. WRPS families will register for courses through their Skyward Family Access account, and non-WRPS students will register through the links provided in each individual booklet. All [Summer School](#) information describing courses and the registration process can be found on the District website at www.wrps.org.

Note that we need to be certain that we have the most up-to-date information for your child(ren). As such, if you originally signed up for Summer School during the last registration round through Family Access, it will appear as though your registration was *successfully completed*; however, it is necessary for you to go back through all of the steps and verify every screen – additionally, **new** to the registration process is a survey question that we included about the possibility of online Summer School – we would appreciate your feedback on that question. Below you will see an example of the screen where you will need to click on “Mark Summer School Registration as Not Completed and Make Changes” to complete all of the necessary steps.
