Dear Parents and Guardians:

You are likely aware of the Wisconsin Supreme Court decision of May 13, 2020 that struck down parts of the Governor's "Safer at Home" Order which closed schools and businesses throughout the State until at least May 26, 2020. The District has been reviewing the Supreme Court's decision and has received several legal opinions that indicate that the Supreme Court's action does NOT affect schools. The primary portion of the Order that has been invalidated impacts private businesses.

As it stands now, we will continue with what has been communicated by the District and your child(ren)'s school(s) up until now. At this time, all schools and school facilities remain closed through June 30, 2020 in compliance with the Order. If this changes, we will notify students, parents, and the community as soon as possible.

Just a quick reminder as well that the WRPS [Food Service](#) program will continue providing free meals to all children ages 18 and under through at least Monday, June 29, 2020. Meals will continue to be provided on Mondays and Thursdays only, with enough food sent home with families for their children to have meals on the days in between. With regard to the upcoming Memorial Day holiday, meals will be served on Tuesday, May 26th instead of Monday, May 25th.
