




FOLLOW-UP COMMUNICATION ON TRANSPORTATION/BUSING

In July, 2017, parents received a letter concerning bus transportation for the upcoming 2017-18 school year. We appreciate your patience and the questions you have brought up to either WRPS, or our bus companies who schedule all of the routes. In an attempt to continue the open line of communication, and help parents understand more about the bus information in <u>Family Access</u>, WRPS has developed this document to further assist parents in understanding how to access their child's bus information, and who to call if they have a question about the bus route.

Parents can check their student's bus route information by going into <u>Family Access</u> as indicated below. NOTE – your student will either be riding a *Safe Way* bus route, or a *Lamers* bus route. If it is a <u>Lamers</u> route, the bus route number will have an "L" at the beginning of the number – *the last page of this communication piece shows an example of what that will look like in Family Access*.
