- Listening to music while working on math homework *during individual work time.*

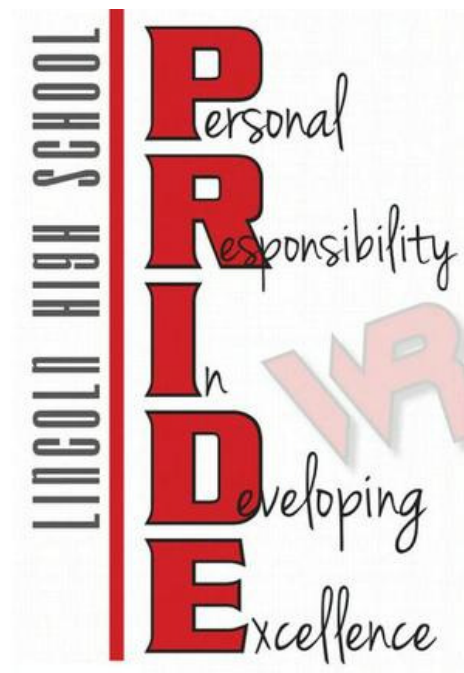
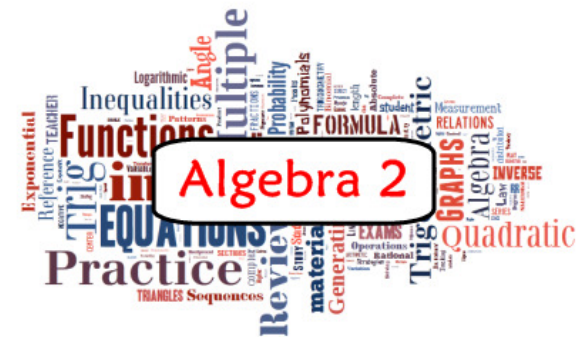

Retake Policy: Students may retake a maximum of 2 Summative Assessments (either a quiz or a test) per semester on which the student earned less than an 85%. The highest grade on the assessment, up to a maximum of 85%, will be the final grade. No retakes will be allowed during the final 10 days of the semester.
