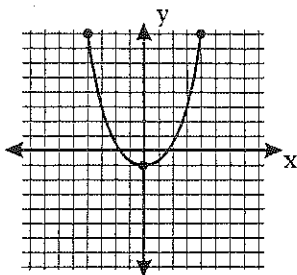


Domain and Range

Find the domain and range from the graph.

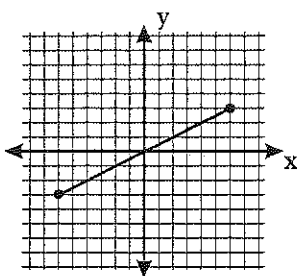
Each box on the graph equals 1 unit.

Example:



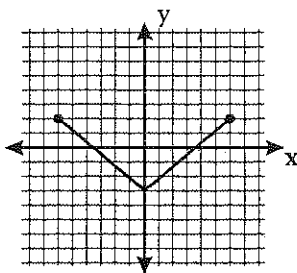
Domain: $-4 \leq x \leq 4$

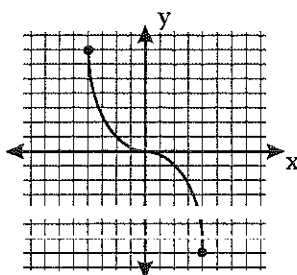
Domain: $-6 \leq x \leq 6$

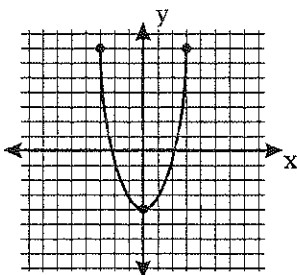
Domain: $-6 \leq x \leq 6$

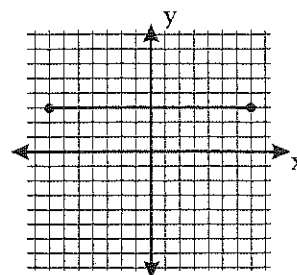
Domain: $-4 \leq x \leq 4$

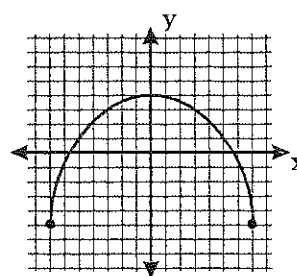
Domain: $-3 \leq x \leq 3$

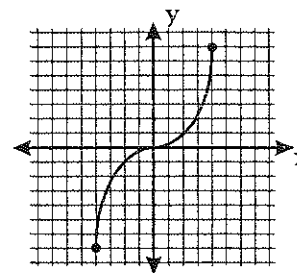
Domain: $-7 \leq x \leq 7$

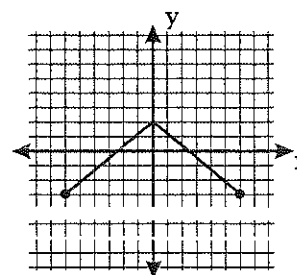
Domain: $-7 \leq x \leq 7$

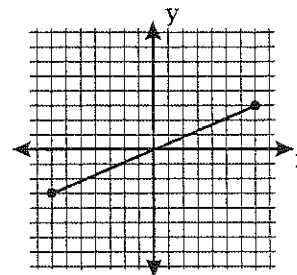
Domain: $-4 \leq x \leq 4$
