4-Year-Old Kindergarten Registration

- ◆ Your child must be 4 years old by September 1, 2021.
- ◆ At the time of registration you will be able to indicate your site preference. Tentative sites for the 2021-22 school year are Building Blocks Learning Center, Grant, Pitsch Early Learning Center, THINK, St. Lawrence, Woodside, YMCA, and Biron Head Start (Head Start students only).

5-Year-Old Kindergarten Registration

- ◆ Your child must be 5 years old by September 1, 2021.
- ◆ If your child is currently enrolled in WRPS 4-year-old kindergarten, you **DO NOT** need to register for 5-year-old kindergarten on the dates listed below. Your child should have brought home a registration packet for you to complete and return to their current 4-year-old kindergarten teacher. If you need another registration packet, talk with your child's teacher. *If you are new to the area or are enrolling for the first time at WRPS, please plan to register on one of the dates indicated.*

Registration will be held at the district's Enrollment Center, 311 Lincoln Street (formerly East Junior High) on the following dates. **Masks are required and social distancing will be observed:**

- Tuesday, March 2, 12:00 noon – 6:00 p.m.**
- Wednesday, March 3, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**
- Thursday, March 4, 12:00 noon – 6:00 p.m.**

Starting with the 2021-22 school year we are excited to open the Pitsch Early Learning Center. This center will house four 4K classrooms and four early childhood classrooms. Current 4K sites that will be relocated to Pitsch include one section of BBLC, Grove and Mead. BBLC w/LOT will continue at Pitsch, and no 4K will be offered at Grove and Mead starting with the 2021-22 school year.
