## BOUNDARY EXCEPTION OR OPEN ENROLLMENT

WHICH ONE APPLIES TO ME? WHEN DO I APPLY?



<u>The difference between</u> a boundary exception and open enrollment is that **boundary exceptions are for** students in grades KG-5 who <u>reside in</u> the Wisconsin Rapids Public School District, but wish to attend a different WRPS school outside of their normal attendance boundary area (*for example, you reside in the Howe Elementary attendance area, but wish to have your children go to Mead Elementary*).

**Open enrollment is the process** to use when your child (grades 4K-12) resides in one school district, but you would like your child to attend school in a different district (*for example, you live in Stevens Point, but would like your children to attend school in Wisconsin Rapids*).

Both the boundary exception and open enrollment processes have very specific guidelines to follow in order to apply. Procedures for both are explained on the WRPS website under the "Parents" tab found at the top of our homepage (<a href="http://www.wrps.org/">http://www.wrps.org/</a>). Boundary exceptions use a <a href="paper form">paper form</a> process, while open enrollment uses an <a href="on-line process">on-line process</a> hosted through the Department of Public Instruction website.

It is crucial for families who wish to have their children attend a school, other than the one they would normally attend within their attendance boundary area, to choose the correct process (boundary exception vs. open enrollment) and *meet the required deadline* to apply.

The timeframe to apply for boundary exceptions for 2020-21 is **February 3-28, 2020.** 

The timeframe to apply for open enrollment is February 3, 2020 through April 30, 2020.
