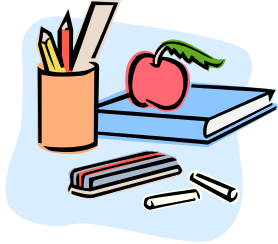

REGISTRATION

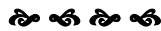


2019-2020 School Hours

Breakfast is served at all schools. Breakfast prices are as follows:

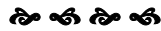
Elementary Schools: \$1.25/meal

TRANSPORTATION

Parents of all kindergarten pupils, or pupils new to the District, who meet eligibility requirements for busing should receive busing information by U.S. Mail. Kindergarten students should ride the school bus the first day of school. Bus pick-up/drop-off and routing questions should be directed to Safe Way Bus at 715-423-1117. All other questions related to bus transportation, pay-to-ride contracts, or elementary school boundaries should be directed to Ann Arendt at 715-424-6700.



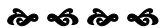
Pupil Non-Discrimination/Harassment Policy

The School District of Wisconsin Rapids is committed to equal educational opportunity for all District students. The District will not deny any person admission to, participation in, or the benefits of any curricular, extra-curricular, pupil services, recreational or other program or activity because of a person's gender, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, transgender status, gender identity, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability, or any other characteristic protected under State or Federal civil rights laws. Bullying Prohibited

The School District of Wisconsin Rapids strives to provide a safe, secure and respectful learning environment for all students in school buildings, on school grounds, and school buses and at school-sponsored activities. Bullying has a harmful social, physical, psychological and academic impact on bullies, victims and bystanders. Bullying behavior is prohibited in all schools, buildings, property and educational environments, including any property or vehicle owned, leased or used by the District. This includes public transportation regularly used by students to go to and from school. Educational environments include every activity under school supervision. All school staff members and school officials who observe or become aware of acts of bullying are required to report these acts to the building principal. Any other person, including a student who is either a victim of the bullying or is aware of the bullying or any other concerned individual is encouraged to report the conduct to the building principal. Reports of bullying will be addressed immediately in accordance with Board Policy [411.5](#).
