The City of Wisconsin Rapids has school crossing guard positions open, and would like your help in spreading the word to potential candidates!

Available shifts include:

Chase/Expressway – Afternoon Crossing

2:35-3:10 p.m. on Monday

3:30-4:05 p.m. on Tuesday through Friday

17th Avenue/West Grand Avenue – Afternoon Crossing

2:25-3:00 p.m. on Mondays only

Also – there is an *Alternate Crossing Guard* position open for Monday and Tuesday MORNINGS only. Shifts are approximately 7:45-8:45 a.m. and 3:15-4:15 p.m. on school days. A person could work morning or afternoon shifts, or both shifts.

Compensation is \$11.60 to \$12.76 per crossing. CPR and First Aid training is preferred, and applicants must pass a drug screen as well as vision and audiometric test. Must be able to work in inclement weather – the goal is to have people start in time for the first day of school on September 1.
