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A. Lincoln High School: Five Period-Trimester Schedule

Ronald Rasmussen, Principal of Lincoln High School was present at the June, 2014 Educational Services Committee meeting to update the Board on the work that had been done by the Lincoln High School Scheduling Committee, as well as the Lincoln High School staff. Mr. Rasmussen's presentation included information about the committees' work, as well as the advantages and disadvantages of a five period-trimester schedule.

On Wednesday, May 28, 2014, an advisory ballot was taken by the LHS faculty. Eighty-three point one percent (83.1%) were in favor of a five period-trimester schedule. Sixteen point nine percent (16.9%) were opposed.

Mr. Rasmussen will be present to answer some remaining questions about the trimester schedule as well as explain the process Lincoln High School would take if they implement a five period-trimester schedule, beginning in the 2015-16 school year.

The administration recommends approval of the implementation of a five period-trimester schedule at Lincoln High School beginning in the 2015-16 school year.
