A. Strategic Plan Update

Colleen Dickmann, Superintendent, and members of the Strategic Plan Committee, will be present to update the Educational Services Committee on the Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools' Strategic Plan. Progress toward goals, as well as next steps will be shared.

The administration recommends approval of the updated Wisconsin Rapids Public Schools' Strategic Plan

B. ACT and WorkKeys Administration Schedule

As part of the Wisconsin Student Assessment System (WSAS), all Juniors throughout the state of Wisconsin will be taking the ACT on March 3, 2015 and the ACT WorkKeys on March 4, 2015. These assessments require approximately four to five hours for test administration and completion.

To administer the ACT and WorkKeys effectively, as well as provide for necessary student accommodations, a minimum of thirty-six classrooms are required. In order to accomplish this, sophomores and seniors will need to have a late start on those days. Sophomores and juniors could ride the bus and come to school at the regular time. However, during the time the juniors are testing, they would remain in a supervised setting in the cafeteria or the gymnasium. Otherwise, they would have the option of finding their own ride to school for the late start. Lunch would

be provided for all three grades on both days. The schedule for each day would be as follows:

March 3, 2015: ACT Test Administration

7:30 a.m. – 12:58 p.m. Testing for Juniors and Late Start Sophomores and

Seniors

12:58 – 2:51 p.m. Periods 1, 2 and 3 classes for all students

March 4, 2015: WorkKeys Test Administration

7:30 – 11:40 a.m. Testing for Juniors and Late Start for Sophomores

and

Seniors

11:40 a.m. – 2:51 p.m. Periods 4, 5, 6 and 7 classes for all students

The administration recommends approval of a revised schedule including a late start for sophomores and seniors at Lincoln High School on March 3 and 4, 2015 in order to accommodate the administration of the ACT and the ACT WorkKeys to all juniors.
