Ronald Rasmussen, Principal of Lincoln High School, introduced members of the Scheduling Committee: Lynn Borski, Tracy Hauke, Julie Hepp, and Stacy Moyer. He then presented a PowerPoint reviewing the Committees' work, including the pros and cons of a five period-trimester schedule. It was noted that periods are best utilized when broken into three sections to hold student interest and attention span. A tentative daily schedule was shared. Professional development opportunities will be available to staff that will assist them in acclimating to the new schedule. Concerns for traveling teachers will also be addressed, and teachers at WRAMS and EJH will be invited to attend professional development opportunities.
