A. 66.03.01 InterDistrict Agreement – Approval

A Wisconsin Rapids resident student who is participating in a program in Nekoosa School District wishes to continue that program for the remainder of the school year under a cooperative 66.03.01 agreement.

The District with which we need an approved 66.03.01 agreement at this time is as follows:

Student Out

School District of Nekoosa – 1 student – grade 5K – Classroom

The administration recommends the 66.03.01 cooperative agreement for a student enrolling out to Nekoosa School District be recommended for approval to the Board of Education.

B. Intercom System – Performing Arts Center (PAC) – Approval

The Performing Arts Center (PAC) has a hard-wired in-house communication system with the ability for four (4) wireless users. The wireless component has been having various issues such as faulty beltpacks, terrible static, amongst other intermittent problems. This system provides PAC technicians and event staff the ability to communicate throughout the venue and allows the user the ability to move freely about the facility. This capability has become a necessary requirement for most events. The exact age of this wireless system is unknown, but estimated to be between 10-12 years old.

The proposed system will replace the malfunctioning base station and beltpacks. It would provide an upgrade to six (6) beltpacks to provide communication to a lead usher and facility director, while still providing four (4) beltpacks to event staff and technicians. Other alternatives such as two-way radios were explored. Although less costly, this solution proved to be inadequate for our venue communication. There are minimum requirements we must meet when considering communication solutions in a performance/event space.

The quote provided for this solution is from Soundworks in Stevens Point. They are the preferred vendor for this purchase due to their existing knowledge of our system and ability to provide an accurate bid on necessary equipment. Other companies were contacted but did not have the resources to provide an accurate solution.

The quote for replacement of the Intercom System in the Performing Arts Center (PAC) from Soundworks System Inc. was \$16,448.70.

The administration recommends that the proposal to purchase an intercom system for use in the Performing Arts Center from Soundworks Systems Inc. at a cost of \$16,448.70 to be funded from the Committee Service Fund 80 be recommended for approval to the Board of Education.

A. Purchase – Update

A copy of an invoice from K12-Fueleducation for Virtual School curriculum materials is included as Attachment A.

B. General Equipment Purchase – Performing Arts Center (PAC) – Update

The PAC is in need of upgraded equipment and general maintenance items to continue providing current and efficient service to a variety of event requirements. A few items of particular importance are the replacement lamps for our lighting fixtures. In addition, cabling and accessories are needed to integrate intelligent lighting instruments into our system. We are currently using equipment that is not designed for the purpose, and is problematic at times. There are additional odds and ends such as sandbags, power cables, riser skirts, and other miscellaneous parts to repair broken cables, fix headsets, etc. These items provide increased longevity to otherwise unusable equipment, increase our efficiency, and improve our ability to produce quality events for school and community.

Out of four companies contacted, only Soundworks Systems from Stevens Point is able to provide all the items at competitive pricing, in most cases beating prices on same items elsewhere (Attachment B). Soundworks is being used as the vendor for this purchase due to the price and convenience.

C. Maintenance Vehicle Purchase – Update

The Building and Grounds Department has been using a 1995 maintenance van that has developed problems with the ABS breaking system along with sundry other safety and maintenance concerns resulting in the repair costs exceeding the value of the vehicle. Bruns and Sons located a 2011 Ford Econoline Van at auction for the School District at a total cost of \$12,988.00. The vehicle has interior racks and shelving already installed and will only need to have the overhead rack transferred from the old van. The new van was picked up on October 29, 2015 and the old van will be junked after tires and the remaining interior racks have been removed.

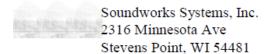
