Many of the overhead projectors in classrooms are failing. Technology Director, Philip Bickelhaupt has received an excellent quote from Tierney for (43) projectors to replace projectors in three elementary buildings.

The Administration recommends that the proposal to purchase (43) projectors from Tierney at a total cost of \$20,341.15 with funding from Technology Referendum Funds be recommended for approval to the Board of Education.
