> A. Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) Program – Food Service

> > Since the 2014-15 school year, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) have offered schools the opportunity to participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). CEP is a four year reimbursement option for schools participating in both the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) that wish to offer free school meals to all children in high poverty schools without collecting household applications. The Administration recommends offering this program at Mead Elementary and River Cities High School beginning in the 2016-17 school year. Lizzie Severson, Food Service Director, will be present at the committee meeting to further explain the Community Eligibility Provision and how it could be beneficial for the students at Mead Elementary and River Cities High School.

> > The Administration recommends that the proposed participation offering the Community Eligibility Provision program for both the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) offered at Mead Elementary and River Cities High School for four (4) years beginning in the 2016-17 school year be recommended for approval to the Board of Education.
