210 ADMINISTRATION GOALS

The School District administration is responsible for the direction, coordination and control of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals adopted by the Board of Education within the guidelines established by Board policy, the law and employee agreements.

To demonstrate leadership and to resolve the inevitable problems and obstacles that will arise both within the District and in its relationship with the community, the Board expects the administration to focus on:

- 1. decision making and communication;
- 2. planning, organization, implementation and evaluation;
- 3. coordination and guidance of the various centers of power within the school district and the community to enable people to do things together for education that they might never be able to do separately.
