## 253.4 DEVELOPMENT AND APPROVAL OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

Student, staff, and parent handbooks may be developed to serve as the basis for the enforcement of school rules and may be communicated in print and/or electronically. When developed, such handbooks shall be used to ensure that all students, staff, and parents are aware of the rules established to govern the schools.

All handbooks shall be developed consistent with Board policies and state and federal law. Development and/or changes in such handbooks of a substantive nature, as determined by the Superintendent, will be approved by the Board of Education as needed.
