

342.2 HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Homebound instruction may be provided to students who are physically or emotionally unable to attend school over a period of up to 30 consecutive days. A physician's statement declaring the student is unable to attend school for physical or emotional reasons may be required. Homebound instruction may continue, based on physician's statement, for subsequent periods not to exceed 30 consecutive days. The Pupil Services Department will be responsible for the implementation and evaluation of homebound services.

Homebound instruction may also be provided pursuant to the unique needs of a student with a disability. Placement on homebound instruction shall be made by the IEP team.
