

370 CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-curricular activities are an integral part of school life and often require as much careful planning and supervision as the academic subjects. However, care must be taken that these activities do not take precedence in importance over the subject matter areas, but remain in the position of enriching and supplementing the actual courses of study.

All students elected to student offices, or who represent their schools in co-curricular activities, shall do so in compliance with the District approved Activities Code.

Whenever or wherever held, when conducted under the name of the school or school district or any class or organization thereof, co-curricular activities shall be under the general supervision of the school authorities.

Co-curricular groups shall not be secret in nature.

The opportunity to take part in school activities shall be made available to as many students as possible. All students are invited to participate. The exact number of participants shall be determined by the facilities available and the ability to give adequate individual attention to each student.

The School District of Wisconsin Rapids does not discriminate in admission to programs or activities, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of gender, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap.
