

## **376 INTRAMURAL ATHLETICS**

Intramural sports shall be encouraged in all schools as part of the regular physical education program, the noon recreational program, and after-school hours program, in order that all students may have the opportunity to participate.

The school principal shall be responsible for the management of intramural sports, consistent with Board policy.

The School District of Wisconsin Rapids does not discriminate in admission to athletic programs or activities, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of gender, race, color religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
